

## Be courteous, aware, and safe on Lake Union.

We all love Lake Union, and as the lake gets more use, we all need to be aware of other users of the lake.

From Memorial Day to Labor Day, five Seaplane advisory buoys mark a landing and takeoff area running from the south end of the lake towards the north.

## When the buoys' yellow lights are flashing:

- A seaplane is about to take off or land
- Move away from the seaplane advisory buoys:
  200 feet east or west of the buoys

## At all times:

- If nearing or close to the buoys, be aware of where you are
- Consider moving through the area quickly
- Never tie up to the buoys
